Summarizing Relevant Research



It seems counterintuitive, but reading an article from start to finish is NOT the best strategy.

- 1. Read the ABSTRACT and the DISCUSSION first. Then decide if it is relevant enough to keep reading.
- 2. If so, read the INTRODUCTION next.
- 3. Skim the RESULTS, taking time to look carefully at the graphs.
- 4. Skim the METHODS.
- 5. And finally, take NOTES while you are reading.

 Taking notes will not only help you clarify your thoughts, it will also save you a lot of time when it is time to start writing.
